- **Identify the step of the nursing process that is described in each item below.**
 - The nurse writes an expected outcome for the nursing diagnosis. planning
 - The nurse describes the patient’s verbal and nonverbal complaints. Analysis and data collection
 - The nurse changes the nursing care plan after reviewing the patient’s progress in achieving the expected outcomes. evaluation
 - The nurse describes the patient’s problem according to NANDA (North American Nursing Diagnosis Association) terminology. diagnosing
