

Danger Sign	Possible Cause
Sudden gush of fluid	Postpartum hemorrhage
Vaginal bleeding	Cervical insufficiency, infection of the cervix, placenta previa, preterm labor, placental abruption, overdistended uterus, multiple pregnancies, gestational HTN, infection
Abdominal pain	premature labor, abruptio placenta
Temperature over 101°	UTI, Listeriosis, postpartum hemorrhage, infection
Decreased UO, HA that doesn't go away, edema, sudden weight gain, N/V	gestational hypertension, preeclampsia
Loss of appetite, vomiting 3-4x/day, constant nausea	hyperemesis gravidarum
Severe HA, decreased UO, N/V, upper abd pain, change in vision, proteinuria,	hypertension, preeclampsia
Edema of face and hands	preeclampsia
Convulsions	Preeclampsia
Epigastric Pain	preeclampsia
Dysuria	UTI
Absence of fetal movement	Still birth
