#### **UNIT OBJECTIVES**

##### **AT THE COMPLETION OF THE UNIT, THE STUDENT:**

7. Describes the etiology, clinical manifestations, complications, and nursing responsibilities for the patient with disorders of the male and female reproductive systems.
8. Discusses the usual medical, surgical, and nursing management of patients with disorders of the male and female reproductive system.
9. Implements therapeutic nursing care, using the nursing process and critical thinking skills, for patients with disorders of the reproductive system.
10. Utilizes communication skills when delivering nursing care to patients with disorders of the reproductive system.
11. Identifies the psychosocial needs of the patient with a disorder of the reproductive system.
12. Teaches patients about their reproductive disorders.
13. Relates knowledge of community resources available to assist the patient with disorders of the reproductive system.
14. Discusses clinical manifestations related to specific age-related physiologic changes.
15. Describes common problems of older adults and the role of the nurse in assisting them with selected care problems.
16. Identifies evidence-based practice/best practice standards related to nursing care for patients with disorders of the reproductive system.
17. Demonstrates accountability when providing nursing care for patients with disorders of the reproductive system.
