| ____ Thrill                      | <b>F.</b> Turbulent sounds occurring between normal heart sounds. Characterized by loudness, pitch, shape, duration. Graded I-VI                                                   |
| ____ 3 <sup>rd</sup> Heart Sound | <b>D.</b> Small red streaks under fingernails                                                                                                                                      |
| ____ Troponins                   | <b>G.</b> HR > 100                                                                                                                                                                 |
| ____ HDL                         | <b>E.</b> HR < 60                                                                                                                                                                  |
| ____ Heart murmurs               | <b>B.</b> The amount of blood pumped by each ventricle in 1 min. Calculated by Stroke Volume X HR                                                                                  |
| ____ Splinter hemorrhages        | <b>M.</b> Peripheral resistance against which the left ventricle must pump                                                                                                         |
| ____ Tachycardia                 | <b>A.</b> Turbulent flow through artery caused by aneurysm or arterial obstruction                                                                                                 |
| ____ Bradycardia                 | <b>I.</b> Contractile proteins released after MI. Both T and I samples test for cardiac injury/ischemia                                                                            |
| ____ Arterial bruit              | <b>L.</b> Extra heart sound heard in EARLY diastole, similar to the sound of a gallop. Causes include Left Ventricular failure, volume overload, aortic or tricuspid regurgitation |
| ____ LDL                         | <b>K.</b> Alteration of spine often in elderly resulting in altered chest landmarks, auscultation, and percussion                                                                  |
| ____ Cardiac Output              | <b>C.</b> The volume of blood stretching the ventricles at the end of diastole before the next contraction                                                                         |
| ____ Kyphosis                    | <b>H.</b> Vibration of vessel or chest                                                                                                                                             |
| ____ Preload                     | <b>N.</b> Lipoprotein considered to be the “good cholesterol”                                                                                                                      |
| ____ Afterload                   | <b>J.</b> Lipoprotein considered to be “lethal cholesterol”                                                                                                                        |
