


Heart Failure Review

Instructions: Complete the diagram by labeling each symptom appropriately to either right or left sided heart failure (LS= left sided, RS= Right sided)


Fatigue (LS)	Orthopnea (LS)	GI Distress/Anorexia (RS)	Confusion (LS)
Cyanosis (LS)	Distended Jugular Veins (RS)	Ascites (RS)	Weight gain (RS)
Enlarged liver & spleen (RS)	Tachypnea (LS)	Paroxysmal Nocturnal Dyspnea (LS)	Crackles/Wheezes (LS)
Restlessness (LS)	Dependent edema (RS)	↑ peripheral venous pressure (RS)	Exertional dyspnea (LS)
↑ pulm cap wedge pressure (LS)	Cough (LS)	Blood tinged sputum (LS)	May be caused by chronic pulm. problems (RS)
