


## Heart Failure Review

Fatigue: R-Sided HF	Orthopnea: L-Sided HF	GI Distress/Anorexia: R-Sided HF	Confusion: L-Sided HF
Cyanosis: L-Sided HF	Distended Jugular Veins: R-Sided HF	Ascites : R-Sided HF	Weight gain: R-Sided HF
Enlarged liver & spleen: R-Sided HF	Tachypnea: L-Sided HF	Paroxysmal Nocturnal Dyspnea: L-Sided HF	Crackles/Wheezes: L-Sided HF
Restlessness: L-Sided HF	Dependent edema: R-Sided HF	↑ peripheral venous pressure: R-Sided HF	Exertional dyspnea: L-Sided HF
↑ pulm cap wedge pressure: R-Sided HF	Cough: L-Sided HF	Blood tinged sputum: L-Sided HF	May be caused by chronic pulm problems: R-Sided HF


### LEFT SIDED ♥ FAILURE
