<b><u>Clinical Manifestation with Rationale:</u></b>	People with chronic kidney disease would have an increase of urination (polyuria) due to the kidneys not functioning properly.	Hypertension can occur due hypervolemia	Dyspnea can occur due to the fluid overload, pulmonary edema, pleural effusion.
<b><u>Clinical Manifestation with Rationale:</u></b>	As chronic kidney disease gets worse the person is going to have fluid retention due to anuria.	Dysrhythmia due to the low calcium and the acidosis	Kussmaul respirations are going to occur due to acidosis
