Significant Event - Susie

Pt presented to clinic with anaphylaxis reaction. She stated she couldn't breathe, wheezing, pulse ox of 91%, and her chest was tight. Hives on chest and back, states itchiness. Grandma stated pt ate cookie with nuts and had reaction and could not find epi pen at home so she brought pt to the clinic. After applying oxygen, epinephrine was administered and there was no response, wheezing present and stated difficulty breathing. Fluid bolus was started while evaluating respiratory status. Provider notified that first round of epinephrine was unsuccessful and stated to proceed with second dose. A second dose of epinephrine was administered followed by a dose of diphenhydramine. Pt stated chest felt looser, wheezing not present, and breathing became easier.

Patient Problems

1. Impaired gas exchange
2. Deficient fluid volume
