Breathing 01: Type of Respiratory Failure

- What are the most common diseases that occur, and we see the most in practice from both hypoxemic and hypercapnic respiratory failure? Do they have the same outcomes?

Ventilator Settings pt1

- Is there a certain amount of breaths a minute that the patient must take in order to be able to maintain the pressure support ventilation?

Ventilator Setting pt2

- If there is a low pressure alarm going off and there is no obvious or suspected cause but the patient is tachypneic and restless does the nurse ventilate the patient manually? How long will the patient last with manual ventilation rather than the machine?

ABGS PP

- Is respiratory alkalosis or acidosis more commonly seen? Can ABGS be drawn from an arterial or pulmonary line?
