



Neurosensory Unit Part 1: A&P

C. Describe nerve impulse conduction, including action potential and neurotransmitters.

Neurotransmitters carry chemical signals from neurons to the target cell. A nerve impulse is the electric signals being carried to generate a nerve impulse/action potential. The conduction or action potential happens from ions moving in and out of a cell.
