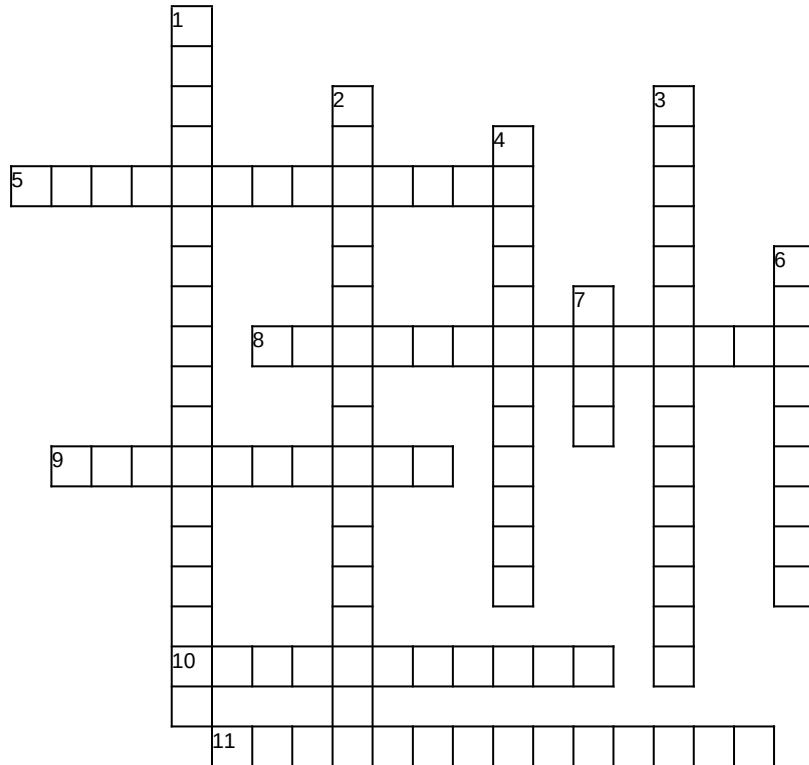

- 5.** Repetitive, rhythmic jerks that involve all or parts of the body
- 8.** Antiepileptic drug used to control convulsive and nonconvulsive seizures
- 9.** one half of the cerebrum, the largest part of the brain.
- 10.** a doctor who specializes in the treatment of epilepsy and other disorders of the brain and nervous system.
- 11.** Seizure that causes a brief loss of awareness

- 1.** Continuous simultaneous recording of brainwaves and video observation of the behavior
- 2.** the region of the brain responsible for the abnormal electrical signals that cause seizures.
- 3.** a neuro-surgical procedure to prevent further seizures
- 4.** surgery to remove isolated brain lesions that are responsible for seizure activity.
- 6.** a conductive disk (usually metal) attached to the scalp which conveys the electrical activity of the brain through a wire to an EEG machine.
- 7.** Warning or initial symptom at the beginning of a seizure
