



Hearing Diagnostic Tests	
How are these tests performed? What is considered normal?	
Whisper Test	Weber Test
<p>The Whisper Test helps test gross hearing by covering one ear and whispering a number letter and simultaneously repeating it in the other ear. Normal results are when the client repeats the correct combo for each ear.</p>	<p>The Weber test is when a tuning fork is placed on the mid forehead or vortex and then will be asked which side they can hear clearer. A normal result is when the client hears in both ears clearly.</p>

- What is the correct way to instill eardrops?

The correct way to instill eardrops is to lie the client on their unaffected side, straighten the ear canal, insert the ear drop and to have the client stay on the side for 2-10 minutes.

 The signs and symptoms of Meniere's Disease is vertigo, hearing loss, tinnitus, and feeling pressure in the ear. For an acute attack it is treated by either a vestibular nerve
