Underlying Principles

- Information literacy is important overall to understand or implement anything. If you can not understand or breakdown information you will not be able to implement care properly or know why you are doing a certain task.
- identify literacy level of the clients and know that it may differ by terms, materials given (websites, readings, pictures.)

Nursing Interventions

WHO? WHEN? WHY? HOW?

- break down information during client interaction to a 3rd-5th grade level.
- review website info before giving it to patient.
- provide specific instructions for client when teaching.
- evaluate / confirm that the patient understands teaching and information.
- using devices like sound systems for people with disturbances and knowing what resources are available at your facility.
