

### Cancer Screening Recommendations

Cancer	Screening Test (s)	Recommended for whom, what age, how often?
Breast	<p>Mammograms</p> <p>Breast ultrasound</p> <p>Breast MRI</p> <p>Newer and experimental breast imaging tests</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- For women without symptoms, 40-74 YOA, and every 2 years</li> <li>- People with breast changes (lumps), as needed</li> <li>- Screening for breast cancer, can be yearly or as needed</li> <li>- Screening for breast cancer, as needed</li> </ul>
Colon	<p>Physical exam</p> <p>Stool test</p> <p>Blood tests</p> <p>Proctoscopy</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Yearly, at age 45</li> <li>- Yearly, for people at average/high risk for colorectal cancer</li> <li>- Screening for colorectal cancer</li> <li>- Suspected rectal cancer, as needed.</li> </ul>
Prostate	<p>PSA blood test</p> <p>Digital rectal exam</p> <p>Prostate Biopsy</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- All men over 50, every 2-3 years</li> <li>- Men having issues with bowel or pelvic pain</li> <li>- Men, clarifying prostate cancer suspicions</li> </ul>
Cervical	<p>HPV test</p> <p>Pap test</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ages 30-65 , regular screening</li> <li>- All women starting at age 21, every 3 years</li> </ul>
Lung	<p>Chest x-ray</p> <p>CT scan</p> <p>MRI scan</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Anyone with suspicious lung cancer</li> </ul>
