Problem: Impaired gas exchange	Assess lung sounds prn	Elevate HOB and encourage tripodding
	Assess SpO2 prn	Administer supplemental O2
Reasoning: r/t COPD	Assess knowledge of breathing and coughing exercises.	Teach pt about exercises and have them demonstrate.
Goal: Pt will have an SpO2 between 88-92% or consistent w/ their baseline by the end of my care.		
Goal: Pt will have vesicular and bronchovesicular lung sounds during my care.

<p>Problem: Acute pain</p> <p>Reasoning: r/t dyspnea and fatigue</p> <p>Goal: Pt will report a pain of 3/10 or less on a 0-10 numeric scale by the end of my care.</p> <p>Goal: Pt will rest comfortably as evidenced by not having to be in a tripod by the end of my care.</p>	<p>Assess pain levels prn.</p>	<p>Administer acetaminophen</p>
	<p>Assess comfort of positioning at least twice during my time of care.</p>	<p>Assist w/ repositioning prn</p>
	<p>Assess sleep quality from previous night at the beginning of my shift.</p>	<p>Provide period of uninterrupted rest after pain medication administration.</p>
