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Anticipated Patient Problem and Goals	Relevant Assessments (Prewrite) What assessments pertain to your patient's problem? Include frequencies	Multidisciplinary Team Intervention (Prewrite) What will you do if your assessment is abnormal?
Problem: impair gas exchange Reasoning: decreased SPO2, wheezing in lungs, labored breathing Goal: patient will have a RR between 12-20 by the end of my care Goal: patient will maintain an SPO2 rate between 92-100% during my time of care	assess O2 sat q4hr	apply O2 nasal cannula to maintain SPO2 greater than 92%
	assess respiratory rate q4hr	encourage use of IS 10 times q1hr PRN
	auscultate lungs sounds Q2hr PRN	position HOB greater than or equal to 30 degrees constantly

Anticipated Patient Problem and Goals	Relevant Assessments (Prewrite) What assessments pertain to your patient's problem? Include frequencies	Multidisciplinary Team Intervention (Prewrite) What will you do if your assessment is abnormal?
Problem: risk for falls Reasoning: fatigued, decreased O2 sat, age, history of falls Goal: by the end of my care, my patient will not fall Goal: by the end of my care, patient will teach-back how to use the call bell	assess knowledge of call bell during assessment	ensure call bell is in reach and educate on use of call bell q shift
	assess bed PRN	ensure bed is in lowest position and bed alarm is on
	assess patient knowledge of fall risk	provide reading material that is at a 5th grade level and educate on fall risk safety and prevention
