| S – Situation                      | Client is decompensating with increased shortness of breath since arrival to the clinic. Called out that he could not breathe.                                                                                                                                                                  |
| B – Background                     | Arrived at the clinic this morning reporting increased shortness of breath and weight gain of 5 lb over the last week.                                                                                                                                                                          |
| A – Assessment                     | Coarse crackles throughout lung fields, respirations moist and labored at 36/min, O <sub>2</sub> sat 84% on room air. O <sub>2</sub> applied at 4 L via NC. JVD present. Heart rate has increased from 86 to 116. BP has decreased from 124/84 to 96/52. 2+ pitting edema to lower extremities. |
| R – Recommendation                 | Direct admission to hospital for IV diuresis, chest x-ray, and labs for BMP level.                                                                                                                                                                                                              |

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
