SBAR	
S – Situation	I am calling about Lane Miller who was admitted through the ED for a traumatic brain injury from falling out of a tree. The CT scan reports a subarachnoid hemorrhage with a left temporal bone skull fracture.
B – Background	The CT scan taken on admission reports a subarachnoid hemorrhage with a left temporal bone skull fracture. Another CT scan is scheduled in 5 1/2 hr.
A – Assessment	Since admission to the ICU, they have become more difficult to awaken, opens eyes only to pain. They are confused and need frequent reorienting. Pupils are still equal and reactive. No other neuro deficits are noted at this time. Their latest vital signs are: Temperature 99.1, HR 87 NSR, BP 152/98, RR 24, O ₂ sat 96% on RA. They report their headache pain is increasing, now 5/10. They were medicated with 650 mg of acetaminophen 25 min ago.
R – Recommendation	Can we call for another CT scan now?

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
