

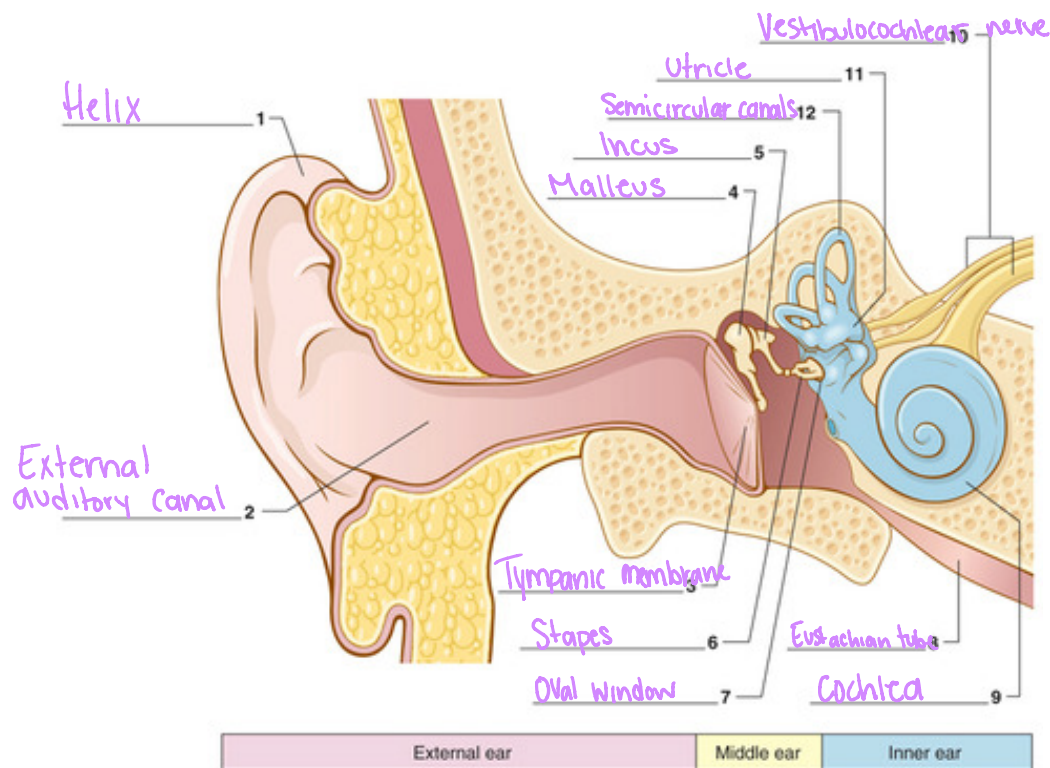
Class Preparation Ear

Hearing Diagnostic Tests	
How are these tests performed? What is considered normal?	
Whisper Test	Weber Test
Tests gross hearing - Stand one arm length away, cover non-tested ear, whisper letters/numbers, pt repeats them Pass if 3/6 repeated.	Place vibrating fork on head Sensorineural loss = Sound is louder in unaffected ear Conductive loss = Sound is louder in affected ear

- What is the correct way to instill eardrops?

Lie on unaffected side, straighten the ear canal
and stay on side for 2-10 minutes

- Label the parts of the ear:



- What are signs & symptoms of Meniere's Disease? How is it treated?

S/s: Vertigo, n/v, tinnitus

Treatment: antihistamines, anticholinergics, benzodiazepines
Vestibular Nerve Resection
