Expected Pharmacological Action

inactive bacterial vaccine that induces active immunization to the stereotypes contained in vaccine

Therapeutic Use disease

Prevent pneumococcal disease

Complications

adverse reactions
 erythema, fatigue, myalgia (muscle pain)
 asthenia
 feeling weak

PURPOSE OF MEDICATION

Expected Pharmacological Action

Promotes immunity to seasonal influenza virus by inducing specific antibody production.

Therapeutic Use

Prevent s the flu

Complications

Pain, redness, swelling
headache muscle joint pain

Medication Administration

IM

Contraindications/Precautions

Contraindications - severe allergic reaction (anaphylaxis) hard to breathe

Precautions - Shoulder injury / oculorespiratory syndrome
acute illness / bleeding disorders eg allergy

Nursing Interventions

evaluate for allergies
previous adverse reactions
bleeding disorders
presence of acute illness
immuno suppressed status

acetaminophen
make sure its before vaccination
