

Cancer Screening Recommendations

Cancer	Screening Test (s)	Recommended for whom, what age, how often?
Breast	Mammograms Ultrasound MRI Tomosynthesis (3D mammography)	Women ages 40-44 should get annual mammograms and 45-54 should have yearly and then when 55+ can switch to every 2 years or annually.
Colon	colonoscopy, Stool based test, fecal immunochemical test,	Average risk start at 45 and colonoscopy every 10 years and sigmoidoscopy every 5 years and continue through age 75
Prostate	PSA (prostate-specific antigen), digital rectal exam (DRE), ,biopsy	Age 50 for men who are at average risk and age 45 for men a high risk and 40 for men at even higher risk
Cervical	HpV test, Pap Smears, colposcopic, biopsy endocervical scraping, cone biopsy	Should start to age 25 and people between ages 25-65 and should get a HPV for 5 years and a Pap test every 3 years.
Lung	X-ray, Ct, MRI, PET, Bone Scan, Needle biopsy, Throacentesis, Sputum cytology, bronchoscopy, LFT	Low-dose CT scan ages 50-80 and have a least 20 pack years of history
