| Cancer | Screening Test (s) | Recommended for whom, what age, how often? |

| Breast | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Breast ultrasounds. • Breast MRI • Breast imaging test • Mammograms | <p>-2,800 new cases of breast cancer a year for men, is about 100 times less common in white men, compared to white females.</p> <p>-1 in every 726 males may have breast cancer in their lifetime.</p> <p>-316,950 new cases of breast cancer in women a year, median age is 62, 1 in every 3 women might have breast cancer in their lifetime.</p> |
| Colon | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stool test. • Visual exams • Blood based test | <p>-54,510 cases for men.</p> <p>-52,810 cases in women.</p> <p>-In people 55 or under, deaths have increased by 2% a year.</p> <p>-1 in every 24 men may develop colon cancer and for women, 1 in 26 may develop colon cancer.</p> |
| Prostate | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prostate specific antigen blood test • Digital rectal exam | <p>-About 6 in 10 men will develop this cancer after the age of 65 and is rare in men under the age of 40.</p> <p>-1 out of 8 men are likely to develop prostate cancer.</p> |
| Cervical | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Colonoscopy • Cervical biopsy • X-ray and MRI | <p>-Average age is between 33 and 45, the average age is 50.</p> <p>-Rarely develop in women under the age of 20.</p> |
| Lung | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chest x-ray • Ct scan • MRI | <p>-119,680 new cases of lung cancer this year for men</p> <p>-115,970 new cases of lung cancer this year for men</p> <p>-Mainly diagnosed in people 65 or older.</p> <p>-1 in 17 men may develop.</p> <p>-1 in 18 women may develop.</p> |
