

Cancer Screening Recommendations

Cancer	Screening Test (s)	Recommended for whom, what age, how often?
Breast	Mammograms and then MRI's along with the mammograms.	Women ages 40 to 44, women ages 45 To 54, women ages 55 and older, all Women.
Colon	Sensitivity test of the stool or an exam that looks at the rectum.	Recommended that people start getting screened at age 45. Regular screening through the age of 75.
Prostate	PSA blood test with or without rectal exam.	Men starting at age 50 or at age 45 with someone in the family with hx of prostate cancer.
Cervical	Primary HPV test done every 5 years or pap test every 3 years	Start at the age of 25 and done at the age of 65.
Lung	Low dose CT (LDCT) scan.	Yearly screening for lung cancer with lose dose CT scan for people 50 to 80 years old.
