Problem: pain Reasoning: pt had THA Goal: pt will have a 4/10 pain scale by the end of my care Goal: pt will improve ROM by 20% by the end of my care	Assess pain level q 2 hrs	Administer oxycodone/ morphine sulfate (IVP)
	Assess ROM q 1 hr	Teach pt to flex/extend legs
	Assess skin integrity q 3 hr	Apply barriers and change positions
	Assess pt walking 2 PRN	Teach pt the use of ambulatory devices
	Assess pt understanding of pain medication q each shift	Explain the use of NSAIDS and opioid and effects

Problem: risk for falls Reasoning: pt weakness after THA surgery Goal: pt will verbalize understanding the use of call bell by the end of my shift Goal: pt will not fall during my time of care	Assess pt use of call light q each shift	Orient pt to call light and the buttons on bed
	assess side rails up x3 q each shift	If lower, make sure three are up, if four are up place one down and place table on side that does not have side rail up
	Assess IV lines q 4 hr	Secure all lines
	Assess pt need to ambulate q 2 hrs	Assist pt to bathroom/ chair with use of gait belt and walker
	Assess bed positioning q 4 hr	Place brake on, bed in lowest position
