Problem: Ineffective airway clearance Reasoning: Crackles in lungs, nasal flaring, nasal congestion Goal: O2 saturation will be above 92% by the end of my care Goal: Respiratory rate will be 30-60 by the end of my care	Assess work of breathing q 4h	Use bulb suction PRN to clear secretions
	Auscultate lungs for adventitious sounds (wheezing, crackles) q 4h	Administer Dexamethasone per providers orders
	Assess Respiratory Rate and pattern q 4h	Administer humidified oxygen PRN O2 saturation under 93%

Problem: Deficient Fluid Volume Reasoning: Decreased oral intake, Dry mucous membranes, sunken fontanelle, no wet diapers for 4 hours Goal: will have at least 3-12 mL/hr of urine output during my time of care	Assess I&O q 4 h	Encourage small frequent feedings of breastmilk or formula
	Assess mucous membranes q 12 h	Provide oral care q 4 hours and PRN for dry
	Assess fontanelle q 12 h	Maintain IV fluids at all times

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Goal: will have firm, flat fontanelle by the end of my care		
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
