4. Patients on **Adalimumab** must be able to perform **SubQ injections**.
5. When should **Indomethicin** be administered?
Answer: Immediately after a meal.
6. **Methotrexate** can result in what complication?
Answer: Immunosuppression.
7. When should patients take **Alendronate** ?
Answer: Empty stomach.
8. **Celecoxib** complications include **black, tarry stools**.
9. To prevent kidney damage, patients taking **Methotrexate** must avoid **dehydration**.
10. **Hydroxychloroquine** can cause **photosensitivity**.
11. An allergy to what food affects the safety of **Glucosamine** administration?
Answer: Shellfish.

Answer: Kidney stones
13. What is a symptom of salicylate toxicity? **Tinnitus.**
