**Answer:** Anticoagulants
4. Patients on **Adalimumab** must be able to perform Subcutaneous injections.
5. When should **Indomethicin** be administered?  
**Answer:** immediately after a meal
6. **Methotrexate** can result in what complication?  
**Answer:** Photosensitivity
7. When should patients take **Alendronate** ?  
**Answer:** on an empty stomach
