


## Heart Failure Review

<u>Fatigue</u>	<u>Orthopnea</u>	<u>GI Distress/Anorexia</u>	<u>Confusion</u>
<u>Cyanosis</u>	<u>Distended Jugular Veins</u>	<u>Ascites</u>	<u>Weight gain</u>
<u>Enlarged liver &amp; spleen</u>	<u>Tachypnea</u>	<u>Paroxysmal Nocturnal Dyspnea</u>	<u>Crackles/Wheezes</u>
<u>Restlessness</u>	<u>Dependent edema</u>	<u>↑ peripheral venous pressure</u>	<u>Exertional dyspnea</u>
<u>↑ pulm cap wedge pressure</u>	<u>Cough</u>	<u>Blood tinged sputum</u>	<u>May be caused by chronic pulm problems</u>


### LEFT SIDED ❤️ FAILURE
