Notes from Presentation:

Biosecurity- the practices that protect herd health by preventing the spread of pathogens

Biosecurity is risk management. It balances the likelihood of an uncertain even happening with the cost of protection. You would use preventative maintenance to prevent diseases

Some risk factors are new animals on the farm and animals that have returned from somewhere. You can quarantine them, have a special outfit for working with them, and use parasite controls and vaccinate your animals to help strengthen biosecurity

Visitors can carry pathogens from farm to farm. Provide clean overalls and disposable boots and minimize contact with animals. Clean vehicles that travel from farm to farm and limit traffic to and from the farm. Sanitize equipment regularly.

Keep animals away from wildlife. Keep feed areas clean, materials put away, and make sure enclosures and fences have no damage.
