### What is Safety?

- The freedom from accidents
- A personal responsibility
- Respect for yourself, your classmates, and property

### The Attitude of Safety

- Positive Attitude
- Willingness to try new things
- Read and Follow all Procedures
- Clean up According to Instructions

### Personal Protective Equipment

- Equipment designed to protect you from injury or illness
  - Safety Glasses
  - Lab Apron
  - Disposable Gloves
- Wear when working with chemicals, heat, and moving mechanisms

### Working with Hazardous Materials

- Glass
  - Handle with care, do not touch broken glass
- Chemicals
  - Mix only as directed
- Fire
  - Keep hair or loose clothing pulled back
- Tools
  - Use for designated purpose

### Accidents Happen

- Report all spills and breakages to instructor

### Safety Colors

- Used as indicators, reduces need for words
- Messages these colors can relay
  - Alert people to danger or hazards
  - Help locate certain objects
  - Help people react quickly to emergencies

Red- Danger

Orange- Warning

Yellow- Caution  
Blue- Information  
Green- Safety Equipment  
White- Traffic markings  
White & Black stripes- Stop  
Blank- Work area

#### Major Safety Concern

- Fire
- Electrocution
- Bodily Injury

#### Components needed for fire

- Fuel
