Importance of Water

- Covers 70% of earth
- Sustains all life processes
- Used for agriculture, industry & processing, fish & wildlife, recreation, hydroelectric plants, etc.

Water Locations

- Atmospheres, Precipitation, Organisms, Earth's surface, Groundwater

Water Changing Processes

- Melting- change from solid to liquid
- Freezing- change from liquid to solid
- Evaporation- change from liquid to gas
- Condensation- change from gas to liquid
- Transpiration- water vapor produced by plants
- Percolation and Infiltration- movement of water through earth materials
