**Goal #2:** Research the vegetables to be planted. Indicate the time they should be planted, water requirements, and light and temperature requirements by December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.

**Goal #3:** Plot the vegetable garden on paper by January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Set 1-2 hours to draw the vegetable garden including the size of the plot, what vegetables to grow in the plot and location, and when to start the planting process.

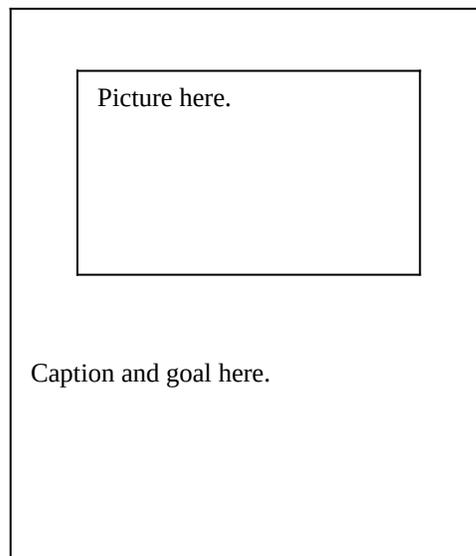
(First Journal due November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020)

1. Each week you will **write at least 1 entry or more** in your student journal per week.
2. You will need to fill out your SAE hours log.
3. Each entry will include the **date and hours** worked on the SAE project. Money spent or earned from the project.
4. The entry should **include specific tasks** and if you accomplished one of the SAE goals you created.
  
5. *Example: October 15, 2020. 1 hour. I transplanted 10 spider plants into a peat moss/osmocote mix. Then I watered the transplanted spider plants. My goal is to transplant 100 spider plants by December 15, 2020 .*
  
6. SAE earnings and investments will be at least \$300 or at least **50 hours outside of class time by the end of the semester.**
7. Total your SAE hours at the end of each journal page. The total hours of your year long project should be on the last page of your journal entries.

**\*\* If you reach the 50 hours or earnings and investments of \$300 before the end of the semester you must still continue to write a journal. This is a semester long project. \*\***

1. You will take 6 different pictures of you participating in your SAE project. This should be done throughout your project.
2. Each picture should show some aspect of your SAE project.
3. Three of your pictures should be the 3 SAE goals you set. Explain in the caption how these three pictures represent your 3 goals and how you achieved them.
4. At least one picture should show you participating in your SAE project. I need to see your face and you participating in the picture. Not just a hand.
5. Each picture should contain a caption of what you are doing in the picture. Captions can be 1-2 sentences long. They should be specific.
6. Each picture with caption will have its own page and can be put into a folder, binder, or report cover, or stapled together. Do not give me loose pictures with captions on the back.

- a. Table of Contents: Includes page numbers and a listing of the contents of the folder or binder. Each page of your SAE project should have a page number.
- b. SAE Project Proposal (SAE Assignment #1)
- c. SAE Goals (SAE Assignment #2)
- d. SAE Weekly Journal Entries (SAE Assignment #3)
- e. 50 Hours total and/or \$300 earnings and investments
- f. Pictures with captions of your SAE project (Assignment #4)
- g. SAE Summary
