

Producer's Code of Care

There are many things we have to do to take care of a dog, and all animals. All different animals have different things that they need to be taken care of correctly. An English Mastiff can and will be hard to take care of because it is a big breed. Ways to care for an English Mastiff or any animal would be, Provisions for feed, water, and habitat, Health care and expectations Handling procedures or expectations, Transportation and harvesting practices Use in education and research Demonstrating and promoting a positive perception of animal agriculture.

What are the Provisions for feed, water, and habitat? An English Mastiff will normally eat at least 30 pound bag of food in a two week period. Now with water an English Mastiff on average will drink as much as a 5 gallon bucket of water within 24 hours. The English Mastiff will drink a huge amount of water due to how much they drool, the more the dog drools the more water they will drink. These Mastiffs usually have no issue adapting to where they live, they can make themselves feel at home in any environment you put them in.

Now we need to make sure our animals are in good health, what should you expect health wise from your English Mastiff, how do you keep an English Mastiff in good health? Well you should expect some health issues in the Mastiff breed as there are issues that are common in the Mastiffs hips and eyes. English Mastiff should have an eye kept on them in their older age, as it is common for them to get cancer as they get older. A younger Mastiff usually shows to have rarely any health issues. To keep an English Mastiff in good health you must care for it, take it for check ups at the vet to make sure everything is still good, and make sure the English Mastiff is in an un-harmful environment, just like any other animal.
