**Duties & Responsibilities:**

- Receive consults for wound care to include all aspects regarding plan of care
- Receive consults for foot and nail care to include all aspects plan of care
- Track and facilitate appropriate offloading footwear and offloading support surfaces
- Collaborate on developing Pressure Ulcer Prevention Program
- Create bi-annual wound care nursing competency checklist which received approval for implementation
- Create or revise department protocols, procedures, or reference sheets
- Performed collateral duty of Medical Supply Technician for two months

**Impact/Accomplishments:**

- Conservative savings of \$300,000 for avoidance of 3 below knee amputations
- Conservative savings of \$74,200 for avoidance of 106 outpatient wound care visits
- Conservative savings of \$45,000 for avoidance of 45 admission days at a long-term acute care hospital for management of negative pressure wound therapy
- Conservative savings of \$26,600 for avoidance of 133 inhouse podiatrist visits
- Conservative savings of \$12,000 for avoidance of 4 simple lower extremity ulcers
- Completed 20 wound consults in 2021 with 56 conservative sharp wound debridements, 10 ankle-brachial indexes, and 40 lower extremity compression wraps
- Completed 67 foot and nail care consults in 2021 with 133 conservative sharp nail debridements, 4 referrals for custom footwear, 3 referrals for vascular surgery, and 4 full-thickness ulcers
- Managed care of negative pressure wound therapy for 45 consecutive days
