

Basic Wound Care Education Presentation (20 points)

Develop a PowerPoint presentation with speaker notes that can be used to teach components of basic wound care. Include appropriate clip art or photos. See the course syllabus for specific requirements on references for all assignments.

Required content objectives:

1. Relate phases of wound healing to depth of skin/tissue damage.
2. Discuss intrinsic barriers to healing that can result in a chronic wound.
3. List the steps to holistic wound assessment.
4. Identify the components of basic wound care.
5. Describe three frequently used topical care categories, including indications/contraindications and recommended dressing change schedule.
6. Explain what needs to be documented regarding wound care and assessment.

APA formatting	References and citations have multiple errors or are missing.	References and citations have errors.	References and citations have few errors.	References and citations have rare errors.

Include a title, introduction, summary, & reference slide. Have 8-10 slides of content, each with 3-5 bullet points and a visual (e.g., photo, icon, graphic). Each 8-10 content slide should have speaker notes of 150-350 words describing what is on that slide. Be sure to address each objective listed above.
