

## Instructional Module - 1

### Mock Scenario prior to Med Admin Lab

**Scenario:**

Date (today) Time (current) Patient admitted to Med-Surg unit post - op R knee replacement, reporting pain of 5 on a score of 0-10. History includes HTN, Chronic Dry Eye syndrome, previous bowel obstruction related to Chronic Constipation.

Allergies: Iodine, Strawberries, Walnuts

Current VS: 120/80 – 60 - 14; T-98.6

**Instructions:**

- 1- Based on this scenario, your patient will need these meds
  - a. Docusate, Metoprolol, Hydrocodone/Acetaminophen
- 2- Examine the eMAR - determine “therapeutic reason” for each med
- 3- Know script for proper med admin (7<sup>+</sup> rights)
- 4- Review Student Performance Expectations
