Medical Terminology Practice Quiz # 4

Directions: Define or Interpret each underlined term and abbreviation from the narrative below.

Mr. Harris is a 36 year-old male admitted to the ¹ SICU. His chief complaint as listed in the ² ED chart is ³ SOB and has been diagnosed with a ⁴ pulmonary ⁵ carcinoma . A ⁶ R ⁷ lobectomy has been scheduled for ⁸ 2130 tomorrow. Dr. Cutter has written orders for the client to be ⁹ NPO ¹⁰ p ¹¹ MN. A consent form is to be obtained for the procedure. Dr. Cutter wants to include possible ¹² thoracotomy with chest tube placement as an incidental procedure. Dr. Cutter has also ordered ¹³ u units of ¹⁴ PRBC to be ready for transfusion in case of ¹⁵ hemorrhage. The client has been notified by Dr. Cutter that this is one risk of the surgery. The ¹⁶ TPCN notes that the client has a ¹⁷ AAA. He has not been taking his ¹⁸ HTN medications as ordered by his ¹⁹ PCP. The nurse will be certain to notify the operating room and anesthesiologist of this noncompliance. Pre-operative labs include a complete blood count, ²⁰ CMP, and ²¹ T&C. In preparation for surgery, the nurse applies ²² TEDs to the client's ²³ BLE to help prevent the formation of a ²⁴ DVT . The nurse explains to the client that an IV will be started in the surgical pre-operative area. The client is also taught to expect to wake up in ²⁵ PACU.

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
