## Medical Terminology Quiz # 4 -KEY

**Directions:** Define or Interpret each underlined term and abbreviation from the narrative below.

Mr. Harris is a 36 year-old male admitted to the <sup>1</sup> SICU. His chief complaints as listed in the <sup>2</sup> ED chart are <sup>3</sup> SOB and has been diagnosed with a <sup>4</sup> pulmonary <sup>5</sup> carcinoma . A <sup>6</sup> (R) lung <sup>7</sup> lobectomy has been scheduled for <sup>8</sup> 2130 tomorrow. Dr. Cutter has written orders for the client to be <sup>9</sup> NPO <sup>10</sup> p <sup>11</sup> MN. A consent form is to be obtained for the procedure. Dr. Cutter wants to include possible <sup>12</sup> thoracotomy with chest tube placement as an incidental procedure. Dr. Cutter has also ordered <sup>13</sup> π units of <sup>14</sup> PRBC to be ready for transfusion in case of <sup>15</sup> hemorrhage. The client has been notified by Dr. Cutter that this is one risk of the surgery. The <sup>16</sup> TPCN notes that the client has a <sup>17</sup> AAA. He has not been taking his <sup>18</sup> HTN medications as ordered by his <sup>19</sup> PCP. The nurse will be certain to notify the operating room and anesthesiologist of this noncompliance. Pre-operative labs include a complete blood count, <sup>20</sup> CMP, and <sup>21</sup> T&C. In preparation for surgery, the nurse applies <sup>22</sup> TEDs to the client's <sup>23</sup> BLE to help prevent the formation of a <sup>24</sup> DVT . The nurse explains to the client that an IV will be started in the surgical pre-operative area. The client is also taught to expect to wake up in <sup>25</sup> PACU.
