

**Every week, along with the specified supplies per skill, the student will need:**

- Stethoscope
- Watch with Second Hand
- Nursing Intervention Instruction (NII's) Booklet
- eMAR and Healthcare Provider Orders (provided on LMS)
- Patient ID Band
- Simulated Hand Sanitizer
- Simulated Aseptic Wipes
- Exam Gloves (Sanitation/Asepsis, Med Prep and Administration)
- Access to a Flat Surface
- Trashcan
- Simulated Scanner
- Simulated Med tray
- Simulated Object for Injection Purposes (ie: orange, etc.)
- Small and Large Towel

**Week 1 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety**

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Sterile Gloving, CVAD Dressing Change, Medication Administration (Oral) and Focused Assessment

- CVAD Kit
- Extra Transparent Dressing
- Sterile Gloves
- Medication Tray
- Oral Medication
- Medication Cup
- Water cup
- Nasal Cannula

\***CVAD Kit** – repack with dry chloro-prep, new dressing and repackaged sterile

**Week 2 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety**

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Medication Administration (IM, SQ) and Focused Assessment

- Syringes (3 mL and Insulin)
- Alcohol Pads
- 10 mL Vial
- Blue Labels
- Blue Caps
- Med Tray
- Simulated Injection Object

### Week 3 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Medication Administration (IV) and Focused Assessment

- 50- or 100-mL Bag
- 500 mL Bag
- IV Tubing (all three)
- 3 mL syringes
- Saline Flushes
- Tourniquet
- Alcohol Swabs
- Labels (blue, orange, green, pink)
- Blue Caps
- Orange Swab Caps
- Med tray

### Week 4 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Medication Administration (Enteral), Focused Assessment and CVAD Blood Draw

- Med Tray
- Med Cups
- Simulated Sterile Water Container
- Irrigation Tray
- Medication (pills and syringe)
- Medication Plastic Sleeves (crushed meds)
- Small Towel
- Plastic Spoon

#### CVAD Blood Draw

- 10 mL syringe
- Flush Syringes
- Max-Zero Needless Connector
- Alcohol Swabs

### Week 5 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Indwelling Catheter Insertion, Medication Administration and Focused Assessment

- Indwelling Catheter Kit
- Sterile Gloves
- Med Tray
- Medication Cup
- Water Cup

**Important Note:** Once kit is opened, take picture for exact repacking. Do NOT open betadine or lubricant. Entire catheter kit must be returned intact at the end of module

**Remember** --- All supplies will be returned to CSON at the end of this module. Please do not throw any supplies away. **Exception:** Used gloves and alcohol swabs - dispose of these.
