Week 1 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Sterile Gloving, CVAD Dressing Change, Oxygenation and Focused Assessment

TEAMS and SIM

- CVAD Kit
- Extra Transparent Dressing
- Sterile Gloves

***CVAD Kit** – repack with dry chloro-prep, new dressing and repackaged sterile

Week 2 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Parenteral Medication Administration (IM, SQ) and Focused Assessment

TEAMS only

- Syringes (3 mL and Insulin)
- Alcohol Pads
- 10 mL Vial
- Blue Labels
- Blue Caps
- Med Tray
- Simulated Injection Object (ie: orange, etc.)

Week 3 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Medication Administration (IV) and Focused Assessment

TEAMS and SIM

- 50- or 100-mL Bag
- 500 mL Bag
- IV Tubings (2)

TEAMS only

- 3 mL syringes
- Saline Flushes
- Alcohol Swabs
- Labels (blue, orange, green, pink)
- Blue Caps
- Orange Swab Caps

Week 4 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: IV start, IV pump, IV gravity, SBAR/MEWS, Focused Assessment and parenteral medication administration

- Clinicals Monday – Wednesday. No TEAMS meetings this week.
- Thursday – SIM Center – skills rotation through stations.

SIM only

- IV start kit

Week 5 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Medication Administration (Enteral), Focused Assessment and CVAD Blood Draw

TEAMS only

- Simulated Sterile Water Container
- Medication syringe
- Small Towel

CVAD Blood Draw

- 10 mL syringe
- Flush Syringes
- Max-Zero Needless Connector
- Alcohol Swabs

TEAMS and SIM

- Irrigation Tray

Week 6 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Indwelling Catheter Insertion, Intermittent catheter insertion, Medication Administration and Focused Assessment

TEAMS and SIM

- Both Catheter Kits
- Sterile Gloves

Important Note: Once kit is opened, take picture for exact repacking. Do NOT open betadine or lubricant. Entire catheter kit must be returned intact at the end of module
