

**Objective**

To provide students opportunities to enhance nursing judgment connecting theory to practice using EBP learning material threaded throughout the curriculum.

**Instructions**

- Students must successfully complete the **required** learning activities (as outlined below).
- Students are encouraged to complete the **recommended** learning activities to assist in mastery of material.
- *Exact due dates and times are listed within the Course Calendar.*

**Grading**

- Graded activities will be used in overall course calculation:
  - **HESI Proctored Fundamentals Exam is 5% of the total IM4 grade and is highlighted in yellow.** Grades awarded will be as follows:
    - ✓  $\geq 850 = 100$
    - ✓  $800-849 = 75$
    - ✓  $750-799 = 50$
    - ✓  $\leq 749 = 0$
  - HESI Fundamental Adaptive Quizzes (x4) are 5% of the total IM4 grade. Each adaptive quiz may be repeated to earn a higher level as desired. Grades will be awarded as follows:
    - ✓ Any below Level 1 = 0
    - ✓ All Level 1 = 75
    - ✓ Mix of Level 1 and Level 2 = 85
    - ✓ All Level 2 = 95
    - ✓ Mix of Level 2 & Level 3 = 100
- Non-graded required learning activities not being used for overall course calculation are to be completed in a *pass/fail manner*.
  - HESI Case Studies and HESI Skills must be taken until achieving a final grade  $\geq 80\%$ . Each quiz can be taken more than once but the accumulated grades will be averaged.
  - Adaptive Quizzing has mastery levels shown as checkmarks.
  - **HESI RN Practice assignments** are listed in green and will be completed for self-mastery; thus, students do not have to earn the 80% threshold.
