MECHANISM OF ACTION (P) proton pump inhibitors
GENERIC NAME pantoprazole
(pan-toe-pra-zole)

MECHANISM OF ACTION binds to an enzyme in the presence of acidic gastric pH, preventing the final transport of hydrogen ions into the gastric lumen.
USES diminished accumulation of acid in the gastric lumen, lessened acid reflux, healing of duodenal ulcers →
ADVERSE REACTIONS CNS: HA GI: Pseudomembranous Colitis, abd pain, diarrhea, eructation, flatulence
ENDO: hyperglycemia F and E: ↓ magnesium (especially if tx duration ≥ 3mo) MS: bone fracture

CONTRAINDICATIONS ↑ sensitivity OB Lactation
INTERACTIONS (Drug-Drug) Ketoconazole, itraconazole, atazanavir, ampicillin esters, iron salts, warfarin, digoxin, methotrexate.
NURSING MEASURES: ASSESS/MONITOR For epigastric or abd pain and for frank or occult blood in stool, emesis, or gastric aspirate.
NURSING INTERVENTIONS Do not confuse w/ Lotronex (alosetron) or protonamine. (P) If receiving pantoprazole IV should be converted to PO dosing ASAP. (P) Monitor bowel function (P) PO: May be administered w/ or w/o food. Do not break, crush, or chew tablets. (P) Antacids may be used concurrently.
