GENERAL INFORMATION (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)

64 year old female admitted for gangrene feet bilateral and ESRD.

Neurological–sensory (LOC, sensation, strength, coordination, speech, pupil assessment)

Pt is alert and oriented X3. pupils are 2 mm. pupils reacted sluggishly to light. Hand grasp weak bilaterally. Constantly complaining of pain.

Comfort level: Pain rates at 10 **(0-10 scale) Location:** Legs

Psychological/Social (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)

EENT (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing) Sclera clear and white without drainage. Ears symmetrical, auditory canals without drainage. Hard of hearing.

Preferred language Spanish.

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

Chest symmetrical, trachea midline. Breath sounds diminish on inspiration and expiration bilateral. Wheezing on left side with inspiration in LU lobe

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)

S1 and S2 audible with regular rate & rhythm. Radial pulse 1+ bilateral. Pedal pulse 1+ on left foot.

Capillary refill is greater than 3 seconds. Patient has edema in left and right upper extremity with pitting edema of 1+

pt has a pacemaker on left side.

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IM1 Patient Physical Assessment Narrative

Gastrointestinal (bowel habits, appearance of abdomen, bowel sounds, tenderness to palpation) Abdomen is distend and firm. Hypoactive bowel sounds X4 quadrants. Pt is incontinent and has a soft, light brown stool.
