

Airway management: Sam

Giving 2 breaths every 30 compressions

being careful not to deliver ventilations too quickly or forcefully

Insert advanced airway & Prepare for therapeutic hypothermia, good breath sounds
O₂ saturation 92%

GoFor/Rover: Switching during compressions were quiet

having someone telling the other to correct the rate of compressions, it is easy to lose track of how fast you should be compressing

use a metronome to help

Good chest rise

inserted a supraglottic airway to help
