Amlodipine	Calcium channel blocker	Treats chest pain	10 mg PO daily	Yes		Swelling of the ankles/feet Dizziness Diarrhea Irregular heartbeat	1. Inspect extremities before, during and after for any signs of edema 2. Instruct patient to call for assistance if needing help out of bed 3. Monitor for diarrhea 4. Assess cardiovascular status before and after admin

Perform GI assessment 2. Inspect skin before and after admin 3. Perform abdominal assessment 4. Instruct the patient to report any signs of numbness

Instruct patient to call for assistance if needing help out of bed 3. Instruct patient to take with small meals to prevent GI upset 4. Instruct patient to report any N/V and insomnia

Monitor orthostatic BP 2. Instruct patient to ask for assistance to get up from bed 3. Instruct patient to report feeling of fast racing heart or irregularity 4. Instruct patient to increase fluid intake
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
