

Virtual SIM Week 1 Scenario- JOY OGUNBERU

It is currently 0730, you are a nurse who normally works in CICU that has been pulled to the emergency department (ED) to help with overflow patients. While you are in the ED, the charge nurse informs you that you will be getting the next patient in triage, a 49-year-old female, to room 11. Their main complaint is jaw pain and nausea X2 days. The ED physician has been notified and the patient has been brought back to your room. Patient is Judy Jensen 7/23/1970.

Answer the following questions:

What is your first impression of this patient? Broad symptoms of heart attack. What do you think might be going on? Heart attack

What other information do you want from the patient? What pain started and the intensity of the pain. Do you feel pain when you chew or just pain at rest in jaw? Does it feel like a toothache? Does the pain radiate to another part of the body? Home Medications

What diagnostic tests would you like run on this patient? EKG, troponin, CK-MB, Myoglobin test

What focused assessments do you want to perform? Abdominal assessment, Cardiac assessment and Lungs assessment

What interventions do you want to perform? Vital signs, HOB up, give pt. emesis bag. Patent IV access

what interventions do you think you might need to do if your tests come back positive? O2 and prepare pt. for reperfusion (Cath lab)

What medications, if any, do you want to give or anticipate needing to give? Anti-emetic, Morphine for pain, Nitroglycerine
