

- ❖ **Why is Sidelying position better for feeding preterm infants?** Regulate control of how you externally pace the baby so they can regulate ballast control and safe when feeding. Opportunity to use back hand to feel breathing and respirations and swallowing and provide trunk elongated position so they are not flexed and put pressure on abdomen which causes reflux on babies.
- ❖ **What are some indications for feeding tube placement discussed in the video?** Infants are unable to take milk by oral route due to prematurity, feeding immaturity, neurological disease, poor oro-motor skills, infants who have respiratory distress, tachypnea or those who receive assisted ventilation.
- ❖ **How long before the cord stump falls off?** 1-3 weeks.
- ❖ **What are some tips for changing a male newborn diaper?** Place a wipe over his penis to avoid getting sprayed.
