Use with caution in elderly or debilitated patients and those with severe hepatic or renal impairment 2. Only take the drug for as long as it is prescribed and only take how much is prescribed 3. Avoid consumption of alcohol 4. May impair mental and/or physical ability, avoid operation of machinery such as driving a car

Take with food or 8-12 oz of water to avoid GI effects</li> <li>2. Consult HCP before taking asprin if you consume 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day</li> <li>3. Report ringing in the ears or bleeding</li> <li>4. Stop taking if pain last more than 10 days</li> </ol>
Enoxaparin (Lovenox)	Antithrombotic, anticoagulant	Prevent DVT, VTE, angina, pulmonary embolism, heart attack	1mg/kg SQ daily	<input type="text"/>  Click here to enter text.		Heparin induced thrombocytopenia (HIT), major hemorrhage, caution with renal failure, history of HIT, coagulation disorders, GI bleed or ulcers	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Assess injection site for pain, swelling, irritation or bruising</li> <li>2. Use cautiously with patients with severe hepatic or renal disease</li> <li>3. Rotate injection sites</li> <li>4. Report bleeding gums, nosebleeds, blood in urine or stool, easy bruising</li> </ol>

Monitor signs of allergic reactions (pulmonary symptoms, tightness in chest, sore throat, wheezing, cough, dyspnea, skin reactions). Report signs of allergic reaction immediately  2. Report ringing in the ears  3. Report easy bruising or bleeding  4. Perform culture and sensitivity test prior to initiating antibiotic therapy

Cefazolin (Ancef)	Antibiotic - Cephalosporin, 1st generation	Prevent a wide variety of bacterial infections	1gm IVP	Click here to enter text.	Sterile water, 2.5mL, slowly over 3-5 minutes	Allergic reactions, diarrhea, drowsiness, fainting, fever, headache, low blood pressure, low platelet count, low white blood cell count, n/v, seizure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Laboratory and/or medical tests such as a complete blood count may be performed periodically to monitor patients progress or to check for side effects</li> <li>Should be used with caution in patients taking anticoagulants such as warfarin and lovenox</li> <li>Consult with HCP if symptoms do not improve or if they become worse within a few days</li> <li>Perform a culture and sensitivity test prior to initiating antibiotic therapy</li> </ol>
