GENERAL INFORMATION (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)

~~THE~~ Pt was assessed in Pt room. Admit diagnosis of acute pancreatitis. Patient was drowsy but easy to arouse. Responded to student nurse calm/relaxed + appropriate for age.

Neurological-sensory (LOC, sensation, strength, coordination, speech, pupil assessment)

Upon assessment Pt was oriented + readily responded to questions. RT + LT grips were strong, ~~RT~~ Pt sclera were white, PERLA, and no scleral edema was present.

Psychological/Social (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)

No family was present at Pt bedside but had a sitter present. Pt was friendly and allowed student to assess.

EENT (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing) Eyes + ears are symmetrical as well as no septum deviation or asymmetry of the throat. Pt has no drainage in the eyes, ears, nose, or throat. The Pt is able to swallow without signs of aspiration.

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

Patient shows no signs of respiratory distress. Pt is on room air with a RR of 16 + pulse O₂ of 97%. -no cough present. Lung sounds are normal in upper + lower lobes upon inspiration + expiration.

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)

Pt had normal heart sounds upon auscultation. There were no signs of edema present or skin turgor. Capillary refill was less than three seconds + radial pulses were strong/able to occlude bilaterally. Pt has no pace makers. Pt BP is 94/54 + has pulse of 71 BPM.

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IM1 Patient Physical Assessment Narrative

Gastrointestinal (bowel habits, appearance of abdomen, bowel sounds, tenderness to palpation) Patient reports no nausea or vomiting. Bowel sounds were active x4 upon auscultation. Pt abdomen was flat + soft upon palpation + had no pain present. Last BM

Genitourinary-Reproductive (frequency, urgency, continence, color, clarity, odor, vaginal bleeding, discharge) Patient voids on his own with no problems.

Wounds/Dressings Patient has no wounds present. Patient has one peripheral IV site in the RT arm with a clean dressing - no redness present (started on 12/5/2020).
