Seizures, anxiety, insomnia, vertigo, paresthesia, flushing, UTI, dyspnea, myalgia	1. Report vision or hearing changes immediately 2. Inform patient that impairment of color discrimination (blue, green) may occur and to avoid activities that rely on color discrimination 3. Tell patient this drug can be taken without regard to food 4. Systemic vasodilatory properties cause transient decreases in supine BP and cardiac output (about 2 hours after ingestion)

Leukopenia, thrombocytopenia, hyperglycemia, chest pain, edema, urinary frequency, UTI, abd pain,	1. Monitor patient for s/s of low magnesium levels such as abnormal HR, palpitations, muscle spasms, tremors, or seizures 2. C-diff associated diarrhea may occur - report diarrhea 3. May increase risk of sunburn. Advise

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						constipation, diarrhea	patient to avoid excessive sunlight exposure.  4. Teach patient that antacids do not affect drug absorption.

Numbness, tremor, hostility, paresthesia, tachycardia, rash, sweating or clamminess	1. Teach patient s/s of serotonin toxicity (dever, mental status changes, muscle twitching, excessive sweating, shivering, diarrhea, loss of coordination) 2. Avoid use of alcohol and grapefruit juice 3. Always take consistently either with or without food but take the same way every time so absorption is not affected differently every time 4. Warn patient not to abruptly stop a benzodiazepine because of risk of withdrawal symptoms

Advise patient to report palpitations or fainting (this drug can affect the heart's rhythm) 2. Warn patients that tablets must be swallowed whole and not crushed, broken, or chewed 3. Avoid grapefruit products while taking

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						confusion, weakness, N/V, dyspnea	this drug  4. Drug prolongs the QT interval according to the dose, if drug is given with another drug(s) that prolong the QTc interval, sudden death could occur
Tiotropim Inhaler	Respiratory long-acting muscarinic antagonists (LAMA)	Anticholinergic bronchodilator	18 mcg, inhalation daily	Click here to enter text.		Bowel obstruction, hypersensitivity reaction, angle-closure glaucoma, urinary retention, paradoxical bronchospasm, bronchitis, URI, cough, UTI, constipation	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Instruct patient to report s/s of acute narrow-angle glaucoma (eye pain or discomfort, blurred vision, visual halos)</li> <li>2. Withhold drug and notify HCP if swelling around the face, mouth, or neck occurs</li> <li>3. Advise patient this is not for treatment of acute episodes of bronchospasm (using as a rescue inhaler)</li> <li>4. Monitor for anticholinergic effects (tachycardia, urinary retention)</li> </ol>
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
